STAPELIA



- -Stapelia are a type of succulent that is native to Africa.
- -This region has no honeybees, so they produce an odorous flower that attracts flies for pollination!
- -They are great for pest control, as the smell of the flower is mesmerizing to flies, leading them to land on the flower and are then unable to move.
 - -They have some of the largest flowers in the world, with some varieties bloom-size up to a foot long!
- -The aroma of the blooms are noticeable around 3-4 ft from the plant.



- -They require partial-full light, but will burn in direct sun.
- -They are very sensitive to overwatering! Pot in a very well draining soil in a shallow pot.
- -Water regularly in the Summer, completely halt watering in the Winter season, and slowly begin regular watering in Spring.
