

Preparing Houseplants for Winter



CHECKLIST

DATE:

- Arrange plants closer to windows, or invest in grow lights
- Move plants away from heat vents/ air registers
- Be sure plants are not touching windows, as the cold temps may damage the foliage
- Stop fertilizing until next spring, and cut back on watering
- Wipe and dust the leaves, and remove old dying leaves
- Consider a humidifier due to dry air caused by heaters
- Finish any last repots or propagations
- Check for pests and/or do a preventative pest spray of neem oil or soapy water
- Be sure to cover any plants when moving them in temps below 50 degrees
